On July 22nd, 2007, we contacted you regarding our request to Stuart Ashman, Secretary of the Department of Cultural Affairs for the State of New Mexico, to inquire into possible unprofessional behavior and perhaps plagiarism on the part of staff at The New Mexico Museum of Natural History & Science. Mr. Ashman's response made clear that he had not investigated our concerns, and also threatened us with legal reprisal by your office. We requested that your office exercise its oversight function and examine our questions about the professional behavior on the part of New Mexico state employees. We also requested clarification on the matter of any reprisal action by your office against us.
