Dear Attorney General King,

On August 2, 2007, I sent a letter to you in an attempt to bring to your attention concerns I have regarding possible unethical behavior on the part of staff members at The New Mexico Museum of Natural History & Science and that I was threatened by legal reprisal through your office by the Chairman of the Department of Cultural Affairs for bringing this matter to his attention.

On September 12, 2007 I received a reply from a member of your staff stating that your office could not provide legal advice to me because I am not a State official of New Mexico. I am confused by this reply because I was not asking for legal advice from your office. Instead I was attempting to bring to your attention concerns of unethical behavior by state employees, and that I was subjected to an unwarranted threat of reprisal through your office by a state official for bringing my concerns to his attention.

I respectfully repeat my request that your office will exercise its oversight function and examine my questions about the professional behavior on the part of New Mexico state employees.
