Thank you for your reply to my letter of August 1, 2007 in which I documented examples of possible unethical behavior by staff of the New Mexico Museum of Natural History and Science and my dissatisfaction with the reply I received from Mr. Stuart Ashman when I wrote to him regarding these concerns. In your reply, dated August 14, 2007, you stated that the Richardson Administration is committed to the highest ethical standards for all professions and that as my allegations were serious, Mr. Ashman would be communicating with me forthwith to discuss my concerns in detail.

I am writing to inform you that I have yet to hear from Secretary Ashman regarding this issue. I feel that this lack of contact further supports my belief that my concerns are not being taken seriously by Secretary Ashman and the Department of Cultural Affairs. Furthermore, as I have no confidence in Secretary Ashman's willingness to look into these allegations, I respectfully repeat my request that my concerns of unethical behavior by museum staff be examined by a neutral third party. I hope that your office is willing to earnestly investigate my allegations and that I do not need to seek recourse through other channels.
